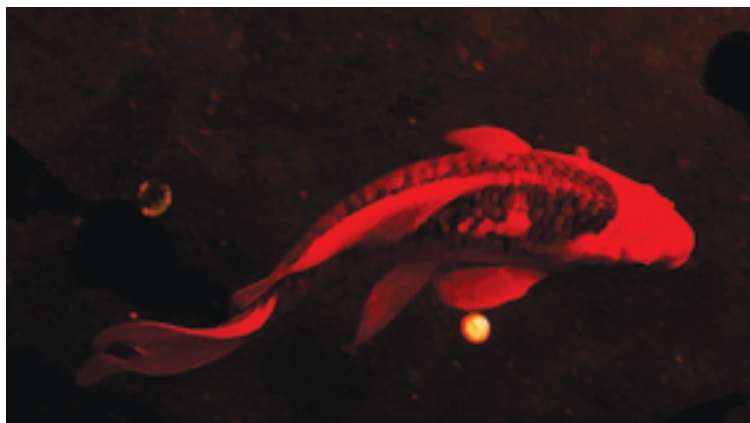


Metropolitan State University announces new art exhibit
