Later in the year, he will appear opposite Saldana again in *Takers*. The movie also stars Hayden Christensen, Matt Dillon, Chris Brown and T.I and is due for release in August. Elba has graced the covers of *Uptown* and *Essence* magazines and was also featured as one of the "Ten Hottest Men on the Planet" twice by *Essence* and chosen as one of *People Magazine's* annual 100 Most Beautiful People in the World. His other notable film credits include the number one box office hit *Obsessed* with Beyonce Knowles, Tyler Perry's *Daddy's Little Girls*, and *American Gangster* alongside Denzel Washington and Russell Crowe, to name a few. He most recently completed Kenneth Branagh's much-anticipated epic, *Thor*, in which he will play Heimdall.
